#### 1. Introduction

This document records the outcomes of our current digital learning plan and school self-evaluation, including targets and the actions we will implement to meet the targets.

#### 1.1 School Details:

• Our school has an enrolment of 66 pupils with a 24% EAL cohort. There are three classroom teachers, a half post EAL teacher and a shared SET teacher and two full-time SNAs. The school derives much of its population from the surrounding Stranorlar and Ballybofey areas. Currently we have 20 laptops, 7 PC's, ten IPads, two visualisers, three interactive whiteboards and one projector and pull down screen. Each teacher has their own laptop. Our current SSE focus is the integration of ICT into the curriculum core subjects of English, Gaeilge and Maths. The SSE plan will be integrated into this Digital Plan

#### 1.2 School Vision:

• Our vision is that of an orderly transition to a modern technology learning environment with the continued provision of the highest quality education. Technology will be used to enhance academic provision, not replace it. It should be seen as beneficial by staff and parents, and as a normal part of everyday life by the students.

- In our school to date, technology is used in line with the available infrastructure. We aim to focus on pupil engagement with digital technology for learning
